FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

Weekdays from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM (reservation required)

- Please arrive at 9:45 AM for check-in.
- Admission: \$15 per child and adult (chaperones, counselors, and teachers included).
- A minimum of 20 children is required per reservation; maximum capacity is 72.
- One teacher is free for every 20 students (restrictions may apply).
- A \$50 non-refundable credit card deposit is required at the time of reservation.
- A 4% debit/credit card fee will automatically be added to all transactions.
- No-shows or cancellations will forfeit the deposit.
- Rescheduling is permitted **only** due to inclement weather.
- For safety, all participants must wear closed-toe shoes.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Arrival (9:45 AM)

Students will be divided into groups based on total attendance.

Groups will rotate through the following stations (the time frame depends on group size)

Petting Area

Learn educational information about each animal, including hands-on experiences with some of them. Includes group discussion and Q&A.

Pony Ride

Children under 70lbs receive a pony ride. Children over 70lbs will help walk a pony. (Please assign an adult to assist students on and off the pony. The pony will be held and led by an experienced staff or volunteer while the participant is seated in the saddle.)

• Train Ride or Trail Walk (based on availability)

Participants will enjoy a guided train ride around the pond, viewing many of our animals on *Thomas the Train* (when available), or take part in a guided trail walk.

Lunch Time

Enjoy lunch or snacks at our shaded picnic tables, reserved for your group. Students will also have free time on the playground. Bagged lunches are recommended.

• Sanitation

Participants should wash their hands/use hand sanitizer before continuing to the next activity.

Departure (1 PM)

Students return to the bus or cars under adult supervision.
